

# CAMPGROUND INFO

## Items Not Allowed in the Campground

- Pets (qualified service animals are permitted)  
Fireworks  
Weapons  
Illegal substances  
Generators  
Motorized and/or remote controlled aerial devices  
Unauthorized motor vehicles
- Items confiscated at the entrance gates will not be returned.

## Water Use

- Fresh water is located throughout the campground.
- Please be considerate of others by limiting your showers to just a few minutes.
- No grey water is to be dumped on the grounds.
- Lion Lake offers shoreline fishing for children; however, swimming or playing in the lake is prohibited.

## Your Campsite

- Campsites may not be roped off.
- Electrical power in the rest rooms is available to campers while they are using the rest rooms; however, it is illegal to run extension cords out of the rest rooms, and if extension cords are found, they will be removed by festival staff in order to maintain both the festival's and the Fairgrounds' compliance with the law.

## Safety and Security

- Safety and security teams wearing bright-colored vests patrol the grounds 24 hours a day, so if you need assistance, please stop them or go to the campground check-in station at Gate 4.
- For your personal safety, wearing shoes at all times is strongly recommended.
- In the event of a life-threatening emergency, please call 911.
- Please note that the first aid station inside the festival area at Gate 5 is only open during festival hours. If you have first aid needs outside of festival hours, please contact one of the Safety and Assistance staff members.
- Secure your valuables. WorldFest assumes no responsibility for personal items left unattended.
- Parents are fully responsible for their children at all times, and children must not be left unsupervised at any time during the festival.

## Parking

- Please observe all posted signage in the campground, roadways and parking lot. Vehicles left in fire lanes or otherwise parked illegally will be subject to towing.

## Disability Concerns

- Campsites for disabled campers are located next to the water wheel just outside Gate 5. Please advise us if you have medical needs for electricity.
- Service animals must be registered at Gate 1 at time of check in and must be on a six-foot leash at all times.

## General Rules

- As new campers arrive, please welcome them and make space for them.
- Trash, recycling and composting items must be placed in the appropriate containers located around the festival and in the campground. Please do not throw trash onto the ground.
- Bright lights and loud sounds are restricted between the hours of 11 pm and 6 am in the campground. Please note that the camping areas north and west of the parking lot are generally for folks who turn in early and would prefer to avoid late night noise.
- Smoking is allowed in the designated smoking areas, which are indicated on your festival map. No smoking of any kind is allowed anywhere on the inner grounds. Smoking is allowed in campsites when done responsibly.
- The speed limit in the campground area is 5 miles per hour.
- Open flames (Charcoal BBQs, candles, tiki torches, etc.) are not allowed anywhere on the Fairgrounds property; however, lanterns and gas stoves are allowed in the campground.
- Picnic table rentals and ice are available at the campground office.
- Unauthorized professional photography is not allowed.
- Unauthorized vendors or buskers are not allowed anywhere on the Fairgrounds property.
- Wristbands must remain on for as long as you plan on attending WorldFest.
- All campers must vacate the campground by noon on Monday, July 18.
